

#7: Description:


Located on the north side of Pomfret Road, the Parker House is a two-story, two-bay, frame building supported on brick piers with weatherboard and vinyl siding. The circa 1900 front-gable house features two-over-two sash windows, pressed tin metal roof, an interior brick chimney, wall dormers, and fishscale shingles in the gable ends and gables of the dormers. The front porch is enclosed and there is a one-story rear ell.
