7: Description:

Located on the east side of Bumpy Oak Road the Carroll House is a one-story, three-bay frame building with vinyl siding. The circa 1940 cross gable house features paired and single six-over-six sash windows, asphalt shingle roof, and a metal chimney flue. The house rests on a brick pier foundation with concrete block infill. The entry porch is supported by square columns as is the side porch, which also has a simple square balustrade.

This building does not appear eligible for the National Register under Criteria A, B, or C. There is no known association with important events or people, and the building is typical for the area.



Resource Sketch Map


