# 7: Description:

Located on the north side of Pomfret Road, the Armstrong House is a one and one-half story, three-bay, frame building covered in stucco. The circa 1930 side-gable house features one-over-one sash windows, asphalt shingle roof, an interior brick chimney, and gable dormers. The house is supported on brick piers. There is a screened side porch.




This building does not appear eligible for the National Register under Criteria A, B, or C. There is no known association with important events or people, and the building is typical for the area.
