Based on available information the structure at 10268 Charles Street, LaPlata Maryland, is not located within the boundaries of a state listed historic district and does not meet the criteria for individual listing on the Maryland Register. The one and one-half story, three bay-wide frame house, has two wide dormers in the side-gable roof and an integral front porch. It most likely dates from the first quarter to the middle of the 20th century.

This house is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or A. It lacks the architectural distinctiveness to qualify it for listing under Criterion C.




