The dwelling located at 14535 Charles Street in Charlotte Hall, ^{CHARLES COUNTY} Maryland is not located in the National Register Charlotte Hall Historic District, nor is it eligible for individual listing. Based upon the photographs submitted, it appears that the present house may incorporate aspects of a late 19th-century dwelling into it, but has been significantly altered and enlarged by 20th century additions and alterations. The house lacks the architectural distinction and integrity to be considered for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.


