Description of Property and Eligibility Determination

This structure is a standard concrete slab, with fourteen-foot span, which has been repaired with new parapet.

We have determined that this structure lacks the requisite integrity as well as a sufficient degree of intact character-defining characteristics to be considered eligible for inclusion in the National Register as a type of concrete slab small structure. To be considered for listing, according to the Small Structures on Maryland's Roads, Historic Context Report (p. 4-10) concrete slab small structures should retain parapets, abutments and wingwalls as primary character defining elements of the substructure. This structure had new parapets constructed, thus no longer retains the original ones. This change has compromised the integrity of the structure.






