8. Statement of Significance
=====

The Piney Church Site is believed to be the original location of the first "Piney Church," established in 1754. Described as a log chapel, the church was located "at a place called Ivy Spring, on a Branch called Dressing Branch, near the Pines."¹ Local tradition apparently identifies this spot as the site of this early Episcopal chapel. The church was later moved north and renamed St. Paul's Church, Piney.

Circa 1900, another church was established at this same site. Known as Brice Chapel Methodist Church, the church was built between 1898 and 1913. The community became known as "Brice," and included a "colored" school as well as a church. Brice Chapel was still in operation at this site in 1956. However, since that time, it has been dismantled, and the site is now wooded and undeveloped.


