7. Description

The site described as "House near Ludlow's Ferry Site" was first identified by J. Richard Rivoire in the 1970's. At the time the structure was in a ruinous state and was being used as a barn. The dwelling, described as being a 1 - 1 ½ frame, 2-room, single-pile structure, was not located at the time of a recent field investigation and is presumed to be demolished.

Presumably, this stood on the current Mirant Generation Station site which incorporates an original road leading from Newburg to Ludlow's ferry. This was also the site of Rosedale or Ferry Farm, built by John or Robert Laidler [Ludlow] around 1780. This dwelling burned in 1955. A photograph of Rosedale can be found in J. Richard Rivoire's Homeplaces: Traditional Domestic Architecture of Charles County published in 1990.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

A small frame house situated near the site of the Ludlow's Ferry (or Laidlow's Ferry) on a bluff overlooking the Potomac River.

The house is of frame construction with random width beaded siding. Two rooms in length and one in depth the house is one storey and has a off center door on front and back flanked by one window ~~at~~ each side of the door. The roof is "A" plan with the ridge running east to west with a single flue chimney at the west gable. The chimney has now disappeared and the house is just on the verge of collapse. Entry into the house was impossible due to its use as a shelter for hay.
