DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>The James Deam Farm is a handsome small dwelling house of the 1840 period. It is composed of two portions, each three bays long and one and one-half storys tall. The main part has brick chimneys on the exterior gables, a porch at the entrance and two dormers on each side of the 'A' roof. The walls are covered with aluminum siding. To the rear of the structure is the other portion which is actually connected on the first story, but is not on the second story, creating the appearance of a hyphen and wing. However, the entrance, with sidelights and transom is located beneath the apparent break in the structure. There are two dormers on the side of the 'A' roof and one dormer on the back. There is an exterior fireplace on the gable of the structure.</p> <p>The interior of the house is composed of two rooms with an enclosed stair in the center of the house which formerly had access to both rooms. Access to the wing is only from the east room. The wing has a hall with enclosed stair and the former kitchen. (Present kitchen and bath in the hall.)</p>


