<p>Gables are the predominant feature of the Medford Farmhouse. It's a T-plan building, two stories tall with gables on each of the three ends of the 'T' as well as two additional gables on the north side. To the east is a two bay long, one and one-half story kitchen wing with outside fireplace. The latter part appears to be the earliest portion of the dwelling.</p>


