The Sherman House is one of the smallest, yet most visually interesting, houses in Vienna. A large, two-story bay on the front of the house is topped by an elaborate carved overhanging cornice along the gable roofline. The inconspicuous, off-center entrance is set within a large two-story porch. The fanciful grillwork on the porch makes one instantly think of the French Quarter in New Orleans and is of exceptional quality. The whole composition is topped by a decorative carved wooden finial.
