

Whitehaven probably derives its name from one of the earliest names given to Church Creek. Since the beginning of the eighteenth century, when land in this area was first mentioned in county records, the town has gone by various names, with Church Creek becoming most common by the end of the eighteenth century.

Whitehaven itself is a handsome combination of two periods. The earlier portion is the one-and-one-half-story section, dating from the Federal period. A later wing was built in the mid-nineteenth century.
