<p>E. C. Flynn's house is a small, typical one and one-half story, Dorchester County vernacular dwelling. It is a frame structure built on brick piers and has a fireplace within each gable. There is a center door flanked by a large window on each side. Three dormers on each side of the "A" roof light the rooms above. Unusual for this type of building is the fact that it has a central stair, whereas, most of that period have small circular stairs adjacent one or both fireplaces.</p> <p>The house is in poor condition and sits near a large oak tree, about <math>\frac{1}{4}</math> mile back from route 16 on Woolford Neck west of Madison.</p>
