<p>Speeden's Chapel is similar in form to Washington Chapel near Hurlock. It is a frame rectangular structure with a large wing on the south. The principal portion has a three bay gable facade with tall architrave flanked by tall stain glass windows. Within its architrave are double doors with panels above, like Wesley Chapel near Eldorado, and Bethlehem Church on Taylor's Island. The structure has a steeply pitched "A" roof with eaves and cornice returns, but no decoration in the gable (possibly obscured by aluminum siding).</p> <p>The wing of the chapel has a double door, with bracketed hood, closest the main portion, and two windows. The window on the gable is composed of three parts. None of the windows have arched heads, which are so typical of the county. There is a louver in the gable. Behind this structure is a leanto addition.</p>
