DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

On route 16 with its westerly juncture with route 14, south of Secretary, stands a two story frame dwelling house now completely covered with aluminum siding. The windows have aluminum storm windows and shutters. It is a 'T' plan structure of which the western three bay long portion appears earliest. At its western gable is a chimney serving a fireplace on the first and second storys. This type chimney appears on several houses in the county dating from the second quarter of the nineteenth century.

The cross of the 'T' appears to date from the late nineteenth or early twentieth century.


