<p>The fenestration and some detail of Warwick Fort Manor was similar to Friendship Hall near East New Market. It had five bay long Flemish bond facade with both water table and belt course. Its modillion cornice is the most outstanding feature resembling that of Friendship Hall. From the early photograph it is not possible to determine if the building was one or two rooms deep. though it seems probably that it was two rooms deep. The interesting porch has tapered columns with benches similar to those of Bloomingdale, Queen Anne's County. The brick wing mentioned in the H.A.B.S. collection can hardly be seen. It was a very grand building prior to its destruction by fire in 1934.</p>

The building was of interest architecturally because of its obvious similarity to Friendship Hall. Likewise the house could have been the product of Henry Hooper, who, like the builder of Friendship Hall, was an important figure in the American Revolution.


