<p>The Thomas Store is a simple frame structure typical of the rural areas of the Eastern Shore. It has a three bay wide facade with leanto porch, and a single window above, in the gable. The first story windows have shutters, the double door doors have a removeable panel in the upper panel of each leaf. The walls of the structure are sheathed with plain weatherboard and the roof is covered with wood shingle. It is built on brick piers. About in the center of the 'A' roof is a small brick chimney. On the northeast side, toward the back of the structure, is a door. On the southwest, opposite the said door, is a shuttered window.</p>
