STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>Since much of Dorchester County is too low to have all mills powered by water, the natives adopted the windmill in several areas of the county. This site is but one of dozens. Naturally, in the upper reaches of the county it was not necessary to build windmills, because the water mills were more permanent and required less maintenance. The water mill could also produce more, having more power available, while the windmill could grind only on days when there was wind and the amount of flour was little in comparison to its big competitor.</p>
