| <p>Near the sanitary landfill in lower Dorchester County stands a small two story frame house built on brick piers. It is three bays long with a brick chimney on the outside of both gable ends. To the east side is a porch and later addition. Its walls are covered with weatherboard. Half of the windows have original 6/6 sash while others have 2/2 sash. The overhanging eave returns at the corners of the building.</p> <p>Inside are two rooms with a stair ascending in the middle of the dwelling. Both fireplaces have late Federal mantels similar to the Nettie Meekins House on Meekins Neck. A board wall separates the two rooms and there is a corner cupboard in the east room.</p> <p>West of the house is a graveyard with the graves of several generations of Gootees, the grand parents and great grand parents of the present owner.</p> |  |
