DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>The Frase Farmhouse is a two part frame building covered with asbestos siding. The main part is two bays long and two deep with a large chimney on its northwest gable, the cap of which looks similar to a house on Rt. 50 southeast of Linkwood. The southwest windows retain original 9/6 and 6/6 sash while the southeast windows have 2/2 sash. There is a center door between the two bays of the southwest facade and another on the southeast side. A portion of porch remains, but it at one time extended on two sides.</p> <p>The kitchen wing is three bays long, but has only one relatively modern dormer. On its gable is a small brick chimney and a leanto enclosed porch.</p>
