DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>The home of Mr. and Mrs. Phillip G. D'Adamo is an Italianate villa style building with overtones of the stick style, The building is a large two story frame structure in the plan of an 'L' with a three story tower in the corner of the 'L' and a back wing. It is constructed upon a stucco foundation and the walls are covered with German siding. A porch extending across its entire north elevation has lost its original wood floor and is now at ground level. The posts are built upon piers. There are very simple brackets at the tops of the posts as well as the gables and cornice of the low pitch hip roof. All of the windows have 2/2 sash and louvered shutters.</p> <p>From the presence of 2/2 sash and small cornice-like moldings above the windows, as well as the German siding, it would appear that the house was built around 1900.</p>

Villa D'Adamo, so named for the architecture as well as its owner, is one of the more impressive romantic structures in the second district of Dorchester County. It rivals many of the Queen Anne style buildings in Cambridge, though its ornamentation is modest.


