DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Wilson farmhouse is similar to the Kral House on the adjoining farm and the Wainwright Farm near Rhodesdale. It is three bays long and three bays deep with a pedimented gable facade. Across the facade is a one story porch built in the early twentieth century. In the pediment are two oddly shaped windows resembling two sides of a lunette window with the center filled. The house is built on a brick foundation and has two chimneys on its back gable. The walls are covered with asbestos siding. The eastern bays of each side are doors. All the windows have 6/6 sash although the first story windows are taller than the second story. Behind, west of, the structure is a four bay, one and one-half story wing which has had part of its roof raised to create a shed dormer.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This building belongs to the group of late Federal style farmhouses which were built in the 1830's or 40's. It is a better designed house from the exterior, though the floor plans are similar, than the Kral House. Research on the structure may reveal that its owner/builder was an important figure in the community.


