DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two and one half story frame house with a steep pitched hip roof of slate that rises to a flat ridge where two center chimneys are located. There is a gable dormer on the front and east and west facades. Across the two bay front and extending around the east facade is a one story porch, supported by Doric columns, having a ballustrade with turned ballusters. The house is similar in design to many that are located on Oakley Street.

This house, probably built in the early years of the 20th century, is similar in design to 604 and 606 William Street, and to many that are found on Oakley Street, and were built by a local contractor named William Thomas. It is part of a block of houses which date, for the most part, to the early 20th century. Although fairly simple in design, these form a block of solidly constructed and attractive older homes.


