DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two and one half story frame house that was probably built in the early years of the 20th century. Like several other houses on this block, it has a steep pitched hip roof which rises to a ridge, and a one story porch supported by Doric columns across the front. This house differs, however, in that it has a two story polygonal bay window on the front under a gable. Also on the front of the house is a hip roofed dormer.




