DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a large frame house of two and one half stories, that appears to have been added onto a couple of times. There are four bays on the front, with a gable roof over three of the bays, and a one story porch across these bays. On the front is a large hip roofed dormer. The house which is three bays deep is covered by a double gable roof, the gable over the two rear bays perhaps having been added later. The exterior of the house has been covered with aluminum siding.


