This is a large frame house covered by a hip roof. There are five bays across the front with a projecting second story center pavilion and gable above. Originally the house had a one story porch across the entire front; however, the southeast corner of the porch is now fully enclosed. The remaining portion of the porch is supported by turned posts. A small pedimented gable in front of the door extends beyond the porch and is supported by additional turned posts. There is a one story bay window opposite the front door to the west. The house is fairly plain and in good condition.




