This two and one half story frame house is similar to several others on Locust Street. It has a gable roof with a chimney on each end and a center gable with a round arch. The front facade is three bays long, and is spanned by a one story porch supported by turned posts. The porch has a ballustrade with rectangular ballusters and a diamond pattern. This house has been altered by the addition of "ersatz" siding made of asphalt.


