DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two story frame house that has been altered by the addition of asphalt siding. It is an assymetrical house that is basically L shaped, consisting of four bays on the front plus a gabled wing at right angles to this on the southwest corner. On the front of this wing is a bay window on the first story. Brackets support the overhanging second story at the corners. In the peak of the gable is a triangular bargeboard with pierced work. Across the front bays, opposite this wing and around the east facade, is a one story porch supported by Doric columns with a ballustrade. On the southwest corner of the house, the porch forms a circular projection; similar to the porch on the house at 310 Mill Street. Around the upper edge of the flat roof is a ballustrade forming an open balcony in front of the second story. On the second story is a projecting bay with a gable above, with a triangular bargeboard in the peak of the gable and a small pointed arched window.


