DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two story, assymetrical frame house, with a hip roof. On the front facade is a gable over two bays. The bay to the west projects toward the street. Across the bay on the east, where the front entrance is located, is a one story porch which curves around the east facade where it connects to a small gabled wing. This attractive porch has a row of dentils around the cornice and is supported by turned posts with fluting. It has a gallery with turned spindles that is supported by corner brackets with pierced work. The house is altered by the addition of asphalt siding, but is in good condition.




