 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two and one half story frame house is basically a rectangular block with a hip roof. It is in need of paint at the present. The front facade is two bays long and has an oriel window below a gable on the east. In front of the double door is a gabled portico supported by thin rectangular posts at the corners. The hip roof rises to a peak where there is a center chimney. The house has been altered by the addition of asphalt siding. There may have been a one story porch across the front at one time with typical late 19th century ornamentation.



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
