

Like its neighbor, 101 Mill Street, this house was built in 1938 and furnishes another variation of the basic two-story, middle-class frame house that was popular in the 1920's and 1930's. This structure does not conflict with the character of Mill Street, which includes many houses built in the late nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The present owners originally bought the land in 1927 from the Eastern Shore Trust Co.


