DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a two and one half story frame house with a hip roof. The first story is covered with wood siding, but the second story has been covered with imbricated shingles. It is basically a rectangular block with a gable over a projecting bay portion on the south side. There is a hip roofed dormer on the two bay front. A one story porch supported by Doric columns, with a ballustrade with turned spindles, spans the front and part of the north side. In front of the door is a gabled pediment with imbricated shingle. The second story bay on the north side of the front project out over the porch and is covered with a hip roof. The corner wall of this bay is rounded.


120 Mill Street


