 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two and one half story brick house has a gable roof made of slate shingles. It is basically a rectangular block with a wing on the front with a two story full length bay window. Above this window is a polygonal roof. There is a one story porch across the two bays to the north of this wing on the front. This porch is supported by turned posts and has a gallery and ballustrade with turned spindles. There is a hip roofed dormer on the front of the house. The gables on the south and north sides are embellished with imbricated slate shingles.


205 Mill Street


