 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a large two and one half story frame house with an addition on the rear. The main portion has a tall hip roof and a gable on the front, over the projecting bays on the south. A one story porch across the front of the house is supported by Doric columns, and has a plain ballustrade. There is a triangular pediment in front of the doorway.


Also known as "Fitzmaurice Hall," this house was erected in 1898 by Cambridge attorney Thomas W. Simmons. Although it has a plainer exterior than most of the other large homes on the upper end of Mill Street, it adds to the turn of the century character of the street.

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
