DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is built in a style that is similar to several other houses on Oakley Street. Basic features of this style are a rectangular block shaped house with a tall hip roof that rises to a ridge, large dormers, and a one story porch with a gabled pediment. This house still has the original slate roof with rows of imbricated shingles alternating with plain shingles. The narrow German siding also remains unaltered. The dormer on the front has a hip roof above a series of rectangular windows. On the south is another dormer, while on the north is a small gable. The porch, supported by Doric columns with a ballustrade between, extends across the two bay front and across part of the north and south facades as well.




