DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is an L shaped house consisting of the main portion under a gable plus a gabled wing on the south side of the front, projecting toward the street. This wing has a two story polygonal bay window on the front. Under the overhanging corners of the gable is a gallery with turned spindles. In the gable is a round arched attic window. Over the three bays opposite this wing is another gable with a round arched window. There is a one story addition which encloses the entrance, in front of these three bays. A one story porch extends across the front of the wing and in front of the door. This porch is supported by Doric columns and has a plain ballustrade. In front of the door is a gabled pediment which extends in front of the porch and is supported by two additional Doric columns.




