DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a one story frame house with a jerkinhead gable roof. The front facade is three bays long and has a Georgian Revival style gabled portico in front of the door, supported by two Doric columns on each front corner. The front door is flanked by sidelights and has a semicircular fanlight above. The house is symmetrical in design with the exception of a small one story wing on the south, also with a jerkinhead gable roof.




