 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame house is similar in general design to several others on Oakley Street. Basically a rectangular block, it has a hip roof that rises to a flat peak which is enclosed by a ballustrade. On the front is a large gabled dormer with a Palladian window. There are two bays on the front facade which is spanned by a one story porch that extends around part of the north and south facades also. Like other porches on Oakley Street it is supported by Doric columns and has a ballustrade and a gabled pediment. On the south, just beyond the porch, is a large gable over a two story bay window.




