 DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a large frame house of two and one half stories. It has a hip roof that rises to a peak, and on the front is a large gabled dormer with a Palladian window. The gable is ornamented with imbricated shingles. There is a chimney on the north and south sides of the house, each rising above a dormer. The front facade is four bays long, having a one story porch across the front supported by Doric columns and a ballustrade with turned spindles. In front of the door is an ornamented pediment. On the south the porch as been enclosed to form a one story addition. Above the door is a large round arched window with two vertical mullions.






