STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Thompsontown is a black community in northern Dorchester County. It was founded toward the end of the Civil War by a black family named Thompson that owned a farm that bordered Thompsontown Rd. At one time ,there were many black farmers in the area but they have turned to other work. The farms have been sold to whites in _____cent years. This particular structure was used as the chapel before the present chapel was built in 1903. Part of this building was removed to the east side of Thompsontown Rd. and used as a black primary school.






