Early 20th Century

Most firehouses used by the various volunteer fire companies in the county are uninteresting if functional buildings, dating from the mid-twentieth century. The large and elaborate neo-Georgian firehouse in Cambridge is a notable exception and is an example of how a tastefully designed civic building can add to a city's architectural beauty.

The frame firehouse in Secretary is one of the oldest in the county, dating from the turn of the century. Its facade is distinguished by a small bell tower and cupola. Present plans call for the demolition of the building and erection of a more modern facility.


