DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE	
<p>Buck Range house is a typical Federal period farmhouse located on Bar Neck, overlooking an inlet of Beckwith Creek, formerly called Wright's Creek.</p> <p>The house is three bays long, one and one-half stories and the framed walls are covered with shingle. The entrance is located in the center of both facades and there is an addition on the east which formerly housed the kitchen, but is now the dining room. A leanto addition wraps around three sides of the latter wing. Shed dormers were added to both sides of the 'A' roof on both sections, while the first story windows retain original 9/6 sash. On the west gable the back of the fireplace is exposed like several buildings in the county. It is only as tall as the firebox, rather than extending to the second floor which the earlier houses seem to do.</p> <p>The interior of the large portion of the house formerly was two rooms, but is now one large room with the fireplace having an enclosed stair and cabinet flanking the fireplace. It possesses one of the finest Federal mantels in the area, and is similar to the mantel in Steele's Landing.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

In 1717 a patent for 100 acres called Buck Range was granted to Edward Trippe who was probably the son of Henry Trippe. Nothing is mentioned of Edward Trippe in the Laskowski Papers, but the Hubbard family is said to have had some connection with the property.

The house is typical of the region and period and possesses a fine interior which is worthy of preservation.
