This house consists of two portions, an older section, probably built in the 1840s, and a later three-bay, two-story section facing the street.

The town charter of 1833 refers to a LeCompte tavern in the center of town, from which the town's boundaries were drawn. If this building is the original LeCompte tavern, it would mean that it is substantially older than 1840.
