DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located on the west side of Pleasant View Road, between Doubs and Pleasant View in southern Frederick County. The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, frame building, now painted yellow. It is in a T-shaped plan; its front section has a gable end facade which faces east toward the road, while to the rear is a gable roofed section aligned perpendicular to the front portion. The facade is two bays wide with a doorway in the north bay of the first floor. The slightly projecting rear section is one bay wide on each side; an exterior brick chimney, probably modern, is located on the north gable end. A one-story wooden porch surrounds the front section of the house. A large barn is located to the northwest of the house.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is significant architecturally as an example of a house type which is unusual in this area; there are few houses here with a T-shape plan and gable end facade. Judging by the present exterior appearance of the house, it may date from the late 19th - early 20th century period. It may, however, either have replaced or incorporated an earlier house which is shown on the 1873 Lake atlas of the county (E.E. Bowersox property). The barn on the property could date from before 1873.

This property is of local significance; it does not appear likely to be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.


