Based on the information provided by SHA, the Claire Shisler Property is eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is located on Gapland Road east of Burkittsville, Maryland and is also known as the Harley Farm. The farmstead complex includes large late 19th century farmhouse, two period outbuildings, and dairy complex which dates from 1950 to 1980. The large, two story farmhouse, which dates to 1899, is a good example of the Queen Anne style, characterized by a varied and complex silhouette and variety of materials. Two period outbuildings, a carriage house/root cellar and a drive-through corncrib also contribute to the property's significance under Criterion C. The property is significant under Criterion A for its role in the Battle for Crampton's Gap on September 14, 1862. The battle opened in the front yard of the house (the predecessor to the present house) and the farm was subsequently used for various quartermaster purposes. Under Criterion D, the property is significant for its high potential for historic (particularly Civil War era) and prehistoric resources.








F-2-101 Shisler Property
