Based on the information presented, the farms at 8610 Willowbrook and 7301 Brook Road, Frederick, are dwellings which are characteristic of rural architecture of the late nineteenth century. 8610 Willowbrook is a 5-bay, 2-1/2 story dwelling with one rear extension. Both portions have gable roofs, although the rear extension appears to be 1-1/2 stories high. The windows are 6 over 6 lights in double hung sashes, and the roof of the main pile is standing seam metal with 2 chimneys protruding. An aluminum awning serves as the roof to the center entrance on the main facade. A stone and wood shed is the only outbuilding associated with this property.

The property at 7301 Brook Road consists of a 2-1/2 story dwelling with a half gable enclosed orch and 2 additional rear extensions, and well as a barn. Both properties have been severely altered and/or neglected. Because of the nature of the alterations, the properties are not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places, based on criterion C, since they lack architectural character.




Figure 7 Map of project corridor showing buildings located within two-tenths of a mile of the limits of disturbance or within the viewshed of the project area as noted from the public right-of-way






Figure 17      Top: Photograph of 7301 Brook Road, looking north;
