The Maryland State Police Barracks located on 3.54 Acres of land at the intersection of U.S. Route 40 and Baughman's Lane, Frederick, Frederick County (west of Frederick) is a 1950s Colonial Revival style building. The property contains a 2-1/2 story office/barracks and a separate industrial type garage and parking area. The windows are six over six, and there are gable dormers on the north and south sides of the roof. The entrance is highlighted by the center gable and a fan light over the double doors. While several of the MSP's early buildings have been determined to be eligible for the National Register, this building reflects the standardization of Maryland's State Government buildings. Although it may have some significance, this example is typical of many such buildings built across the state in the post-World War II era. Based on the information provided, it is not eligible under Criterion A (Maryland State Government Buildings) or C (Architecture).





