The Linganore Post Office is a small rectangular random stone gable roof building banked on a hill overlooking Linganore Creek in the old settlement of Linganore.

The principle facade is four bays wide and one room deep. Large stone quoins are located in each corner of the building. Large stone lintels are located over each window and door.

The exact dates of the operation of the Linganore Post Office are unknown, but it is located on the Titus Atlas of Frederick County of 1873. Local sources have claimed that this is the oldest post office in Frederick County and that it was tenanted to the last Linganore Indian Chief although this has not been documented. The building has always been located on the land of the Henry Poole House which was built C. 1805, so it is unlikely that the post office was built specifically for that purpose.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Langanore Post Office is a small rectangular random stone gabled roof building which faces north from the south side of Glisans Mill Road in Langanore. It is banked on a hill, and overlooks the Langanore Creek.

The principal facade is four bays wide and one room deep. The main entrance door is located in the second bay. It is a replaced door with stone lintels and the original stone doorstep. Occupying the remaining bays are double hung 6/6 windows, which for the most part are original. The Post Office, a random stone structure with large stone quoins in each corner is similar to many larger buildings in the area. The stone content used includes an unusual amount of limestone. The roof cornice is an original boxed cornice which is connected to a tin gabled roof. One original brick chimney is located flush with the west end of the building.

The house is built on a random stone foundation, and is banked on a hill. Another entrance is located on the second bay on the south side of the building leading into the lower level. A small storage area is located in the southeast corner and can be entered through a small original board and batten door. The building is currently being used as a tenant house, and is in fair condition.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The exact dates of the operation of the Linganore Post Office are unknown but it is located on the Titus Atlas of Frederick County of 1873 and the following entry was included in a book about the post offices of the county which was compiled in 1887.

This office is situated pleasantly 7 miles from Mount Airy, and 12 miles from Frederick City. Climate temperate and healthy; land blue slate and limestone, heavily timbered, and sells at from \$30 to \$70 per acre; produces large crops. It has some splendid mill and factory sites, and a fine country for dairy and beef cattle. The farms are generally well improved, and the farmers are thrifty and of a high order of intelligence. The only mill at this place is the saw and grist mill of Moses Douty, Esq. Mr. Douty and his son Edward, and his son-in-law Mr. Suman, are indispensable to this locality. They build wagons, shoe horses, mend machinery for farmers grind their wheat into flour, their rye into chop, and saw their timber into boards. Mr. Douty and his family are the most genial and big-hearted people that you come across in a month's travel. You cannot find a better class of people anywhere than there are here located.¹
