The Eicholtz Log Barn, a hand hewn log barn structure, is located on the east side of Hessons Bridge Road. The barn is constructed of hand hewn logs and held in place by the use of wooden pegs. Two board and batten doors open to the stone enclosed yard on the south side of the structure. A 2/2 window with missing window panes is found in the west stable of the barn.

The Eicholtz Log Barn is a significant structure due to its unique construction with the use of hand hewn materials.

The Eicholtz Log Barn, a wood and log construction barn, is situated on the east side of Hessons Bridge Road opening to the south.

The barn is constructed of logs secured by the use of wooden pegs. A wood siding building material covers the east and west sides of the structure. Two board and batten doors open to a stone enclosed yard on the south side of the structure. A 2/2 window with missing window panes is found in the west stable area of the barn.

The structure is covered by a replacement tin roof.


