This two story log house was the home of John Beall, one of the principal founders of the Black community in Mt. Ephraim at the base of Sugarloaf Mountain. Beall was born during slavery in 1824 in Frederick County, and purchased this land twenty years after emancipation. His descendants continue to own and live on the property he purchased.


